## NON-FICTION SECTION

The Non-fiction books are organised by the DEWEY NUMBER SYSTEM, the main categories are:

000	General works - people collecting facts and books about books.
100	Philosophy and Psychology - people thinking about themselves and their lives.
200	Religion - people thinking about their spiritual lives.
300	Social Sciences - people thinking about other people and the way they live.
400	Language - people learn to use words and to communicate.
500	Science - people learn about the forces of nature.
600	Applied Science and Useful Arts - people make their lives more comfortable.
700	Fine Arts and Recreation - people create art, music and amusements.
800	Literature - people become storytellers.
900	Biography, Geography, History - people write about places, events and other people.

## BORROWING ITEMS FROM THE LIBRARY

S1-4          Borrowing limit - 2 Items  
                  Borrowing time - 2 Weeks

S5-6          Borrowing limit - 3 Items  
                  Borrowing time - 3 Weeks
